ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP	1	<p>Named Individual. Non-Transferable. One voting right. One copy of Newsletter (NOTANews) and other mailings, Journal of Sexual Aggression not included. Eligible to apply for 1 of 5% of allocated places at NOTA Training events at half member rate – ‘first come first served basis’.</p> <p>Retired – From age 55 if NOTA member in the preceding year, otherwise aged 60. Proof of previous employment such as a reference from a past employer may be sought before membership is accepted.</p> <p>Students – Able to claim associate membership for no more than 2 years in any 5 year period whilst registered with an Institute of Further or Higher education to study in the broad field of social science. Proof of the applicant’s student status such as a reference from their course tutor may be sought.</p> <p>Volunteers or supporters (not family members) who are working with people with a sexual behaviour problem will be able to apply for associate membership if s/he:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Is supervised by a recognized employer or agency and 2. Satisfies the requirements stipulated by the Declaration form <p>Agencies may include Probation, Social Services, Health Trust or Authority or voluntary groups such as NSPCC, NCH or Circles of Support and Accountability.</p> <p>Overseas Applicants of Limited Membership – Must provide proof of any of the above status in their own country.</p>	UK - £24.00 EU - £36.00 Others - £54.00
